In 2015, Dr. Hannah received the Canadian Health Informatics Award (CHIA) for Leadership from COACH, (Canada's Health Informatics Association) and ITAC (Information Technology Association of Canada). Also in 2015, Dr. Hannah was appointed as a Member of the Order of Canada for her lifetime achievements in Nursing and health informatics.
